3. Students Exchange

3.1 Student Exchange Programs:

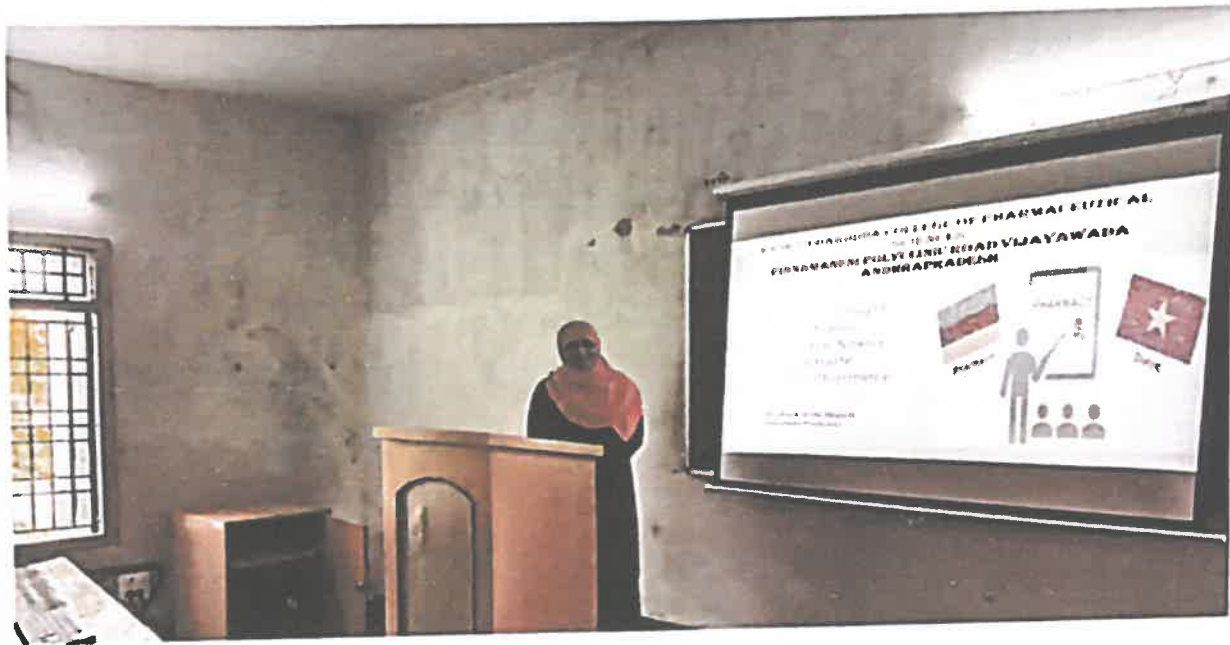

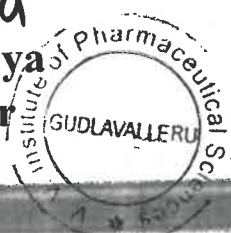

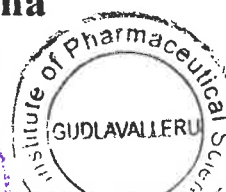
