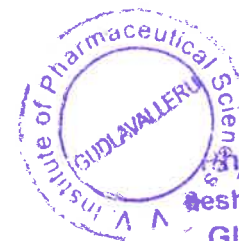

Considering the need of the updated strategies and drug discovery approaches in the area of drug resistance among researchers, in this communication, we consolidated the insights pertaining to new drug development against drug-resistant microbes.

Topics Covered

- To improve awareness and understanding of antimicrobial resistance.
- To strengthen knowledge through surveillance and research.
- To reduce the incidence of infection.
- To optimize the use of antimicrobial agents.

The outcome of the Program:

The open feedback was collected from the faculty members and students they signifies that the amount of advancement in research to curtail the antimicrobial resistance is quite a satisfactory. The various advancements in drug discovery are gene paradox, transposon mutagenesis, interfering vitamin and fatty acid biosynthesis, use of non-conventional growth media and host model for drug screening and targeting the quorum-sensing virulence pathway. Many researchers emphasized that drug target of resistant microbes which are essential in fatty acid biosynthesis, vitamin biosynthesis and respiratory mechanism in microbes would be more beneficial.
