Anti Ragging Committee Policy

Vision:

The primary objective of this endeavor is to build a campus environment at V. V. Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Gudlavalleru that is devoid of ragging. The primary goal of this initiative involves implementing a variety of approaches to prevent, discourage, and eradicate any instances of misconduct exhibited by students towards their peers, particularly focusing on those in their early and later stages of education. This pertains to the matter of ragging, in addition to several other manifestations of abuse or harassment.

Mission:

The proposal delineates the establishment of an Anti Ragging Committee with the aim of effectively averting, forbidding, and treating instances of ragging.

Objectives:

The major function of the Anti-Ragging Committee is to act as a supervisory and advisory entity tasked with ensuring a college campus atmosphere that is devoid of any instances of ragging. The committee's major objectives are delineated as follows.

- ➤ In order to cultivate an environment of discipline, it is crucial to effectively express a distinct and unambiguous message that any instances of ragging will be strictly prohibited within the confines of the college campus.
- The aim is to efficiently implement measures to prevent, discourage, and eliminate occurrences of ragging, embracing any form of wrongdoing displayed by students through verbal communication, writing methods, or actions of provocation, abuse, or rudeness. This encompasses both direct and indirect engagement in disruptive or disciplinary behaviors directed towards first-year students, second-year students, fourth-year students, and other peers.
- The user's text does not contain any information. In order to effectively prevent and address incidences of ragging within the institution, it is imperative to establish a comprehensive system that encompasses the supervision, guidance, and oversight of the artiragging squads. This will assure the efficacy and efficiency of their endeavors.

➤ The main goal is to promptly and efficiently address the reported instances of ragging. Furthermore, ensuring the proper recognition and implementation of suitable repercussions for every occurrence of ragging is of utmost importance.

Roles and Responsibilities

- ➤ It is of utmost importance to strictly adhere to and comply with the directives of the honorable Supreme Court and maintain vigilance in recognizing any occurrences that may be categorized as ragging.
- The user's content does not contain any substantive material to be rewritten in an academic manner. Ensuring a consistent state of alertness is crucial in college campuses and other vulnerable locations, particularly those prone to instances of hazing, regardless of the time of day. The allocation of authority to individuals for the purpose of conducting inspections at the aforementioned locations is of paramount significance.
- > The ability to effectively reduce occurrences of hazing can be found in the deployment of surprise raids conducted in residence halls and other vulnerable areas.
- The user's text is already academic and the academic community, student body, parents, and guardians strongly advocate for the prompt and thorough investigation of any reported incident of ragging. The results of the inquiry, along with suggested strategies, will be expeditiously sent to the head of the organization for the purpose of executing suitable measures.
- > It is crucial to emphasize the prominent display of Anti-ragging posters on department notice boards and designated sites around the institution.
- The introduction of counseling initiatives designed to enhance students' understanding of the prevalence of ragging, as well as the resulting consequences and legal measures implemented by law enforcement and judicial authorities.
- Ensuring strict adherence to the necessary rules is crucial in effectively reducing the incidence of hazing inside educational institutions and residential areas.

- ➤ Student misbehavior encompasses a variety of inappropriate behaviors exhibited by students, such as verbal or written communication that is considered inappropriate, as well as actions involving taunting, abuse, or rudeness towards other students, particularly those who are new to the academic community or any other individuals within the student body.
- The presence of disruptive or disorderly conduct demonstrated by individual students or a collective of students, which possesses the capacity to generate annoyance, challenges, physical or psychological injury, create fear, or yield adverse consequences for incoming students or any other student.
- > The act of prompting a student to participate in an activity that diverges from the customary routine, leading to emotions of shame, discomfort, or embarrassment that have adverse effects on the student's physical and psychological well.
- > The term "senior student" refers to those who have progressed further in their educational journey relative to their peers. When senior students engage in behaviors that impede, disrupt, or disturb the regular educational activities of any other student, especially those who are in their first year of study, it can be classified as an act of interference.
- > The application of the talents and abilities possessed by a novice or any other individual within an educational setting to meet the academic obligations assigned to an individual or a group of pupils.
- > The occurrence of senior students or classmates subjecting freshman or other students to financial extortion or coercive financial limitations.
- ➤ Instances of physical abuse encompass a range of behaviors, including but not limited to sexual abuse, assaults motivated by sexual orientation, forced removal of clothing, coercion to engage in indecent acts, making offensive gestures, causing bodily harm, or posing any other form of threat to an individual's well-being or personal safety.
- The user's text does not contain any information. Verbal abuse, internet communication, online posts, and public insults encompass various forms of mistreatment aimed at intentionally causing discomfort to a new student or any other individual, frequently accompanied by a perverse sense of pleasure, vicarious joy, or sadistic gratification.

- > To ensure the proper exhibition of posters on the notice boards situated across the college campus, as well as in other departments and prominent sites.

The main objective of this program is to provide support and foster cognitive growth among the student population.

Objectives:

- > The primary objective is to establish a system for ongoing monitoring and alerts in order to successfully deter and prevent instances of ragging, as well as mitigate the possibility of future incidents.
- > Moreover, it is crucial to expeditiously attend to and rectify any documented occurrences of ragging.

Subject: Steps to be taken for curbing the menace of ragging -reg

Dear Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, in pursuance to the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging in the AICTE approved technical Institutions, AICTE has framed the Regulations called All India Council for Technical Education (Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Technical Institution, Universities including Deemed to be Universities imparting technical education) Regulations 2009. These regulations are mandatory for all AICTE approved Institution across the country.

As multiple mechanisms are required to ensure a ragging-free campus, here are some recommendations and action steps which are needed to be taken by your esteemed institutions/university.

A. Basic Measures:

- 1. Constitution of Anti-Ragging Committee, Anti-Ragging Squad, setting up of Anti-Ragging Cell and adequate publicity for these measures through various media.
- 2. A clear mention of Anti-Ragging warning in the Institution's prospectus and information booklets/brochures shall be ensured.
- 3. Preparation of e-admission booklet or brochure, e-leaflets of your institutions giving detailed guidance to admitted students in case of ragging, instead of print/hard copy.
- 4. Display of banners/posters at conspicuous places in the campus to create awareness on anti-ragging measures amongst student (soft copy of the posters attached & available in EMMERITARIES.).
- 5. Updation of websites of institutions with the complete address and contact details of Nodal Officers related to Anti-Ragging Committee.
- 6. An online undertaking in every academic year to be submitted by each student and every parent, in compliance with the AICTE Regulations and its 14 amendment regarding submission of undertaking.
- 7. AICTE has notified 2nd Amendment (NOTE Regulations, 2009 to expand the definition of ragging by including the following:

8. Installation of CCTV cameras at vital points.

B. Counseling and monitoring measures

- 1. Regular interaction and counseling with the students to detect early signs of ragging and identification of trouble-triggers.
- 2. Surprise inspection at hostels, students' accommodation, canteens, res-cum-recreation rooms, toilets, bus-stands and any other measure which would augur well in preventing/quelling ragging and any uncalled for behavior/incident.

C. Creative Dissemination of the idea of ragging-free campus

- 1. Events like Anti-Ragging workshops, seminars and other creative avenues to spread the idea
- 2. Safety and security apps without affecting the privacy of individuals can be creatively deployed.

D. Using other UGC initiated measures

- 1. Students in distress due to ragging related incidents can call the National Anti-Ragging Helpline at 1800-180-5522 (24x7 Toll Free) or e-mail the Anti-Ragging Helpline at helpline&antiragging in.
- 2. For any other information regarding ragging, please visit the at www.ntiragging in and contact monitoring agency i.e. Centre for Youth on mobile No. 09818044577 (only in case of emergency).
- 3. To promote anti-ragging, UGC has drives an Anti-Ragging Media Campaign through different modes and has undertaken following activities which are available on their website at www.ugc.org.in:
 - a. Developed 05 TVCs of 30 seconds each from different perspectives i.e. parent, victim and offenders.
 - b. Designed anti-ragging posters (soft copies attached).
 - c. Organized 02 Anti-Ragging Competitions for students/faculty/general public for the wider awareness of the menace of ragging.
 - d. All AICTE approved Technical Institutions are requested to encourage the students, parent etc. to view these TVCs; to display the anti-ragging posters in their website and premises; and also to participate in the above Anti-Ragging Competition for the wider awareness of the menace of ragging drives by UGC.

Any violation of AICTE Regulations or failure of Institution to take adequate steps to prevent ragging in accordance with these Regulations or failure to punish perpetrators of incidents of ragging suitably, will attract punitive action under the AICTE Act.

In pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (g) of sub-section (1) of section 26 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, the UGC notified "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009". The Regulations are available on the UGC website i.e. www.ugc.ac.in & www.antiragging.in.

It is once again brought to your kind notice that ragging is a criminal offence and UGC has framed regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging. These regulations are mandatory and all institutions are required to take necessary steps for its implementation in toto including the monitoring mechanism. Any violation of these regulations will be viewed seriously. If any institution fails to take adequate steps to prevent ragging or does not act in accordance with these Regulations or fails to punish perpetrators of incidents of ragging suitably, it will attract punitive action against itself by the UGC.

You are requested to step up anti-ragging mechanism by way of adequate publicity through various mediums; constitution of Anti-Ragging committee and Anti-Ragging squad, setting up of Anti-Ragging Cell, installing CCTV cameras at vital points, Anti-Ragging workshops and seminar, updating all websites with nodal officers' complete details, alarm bells etc. Regular interaction and counseling with the students, identification of trouble-triggers and mention of Anti-Ragging warning in the institution's E-prospectus and E-information booklets/brochures must be ensured. Surprise inspection of hostels, students' accommodation, canteens, rest cum recreational rooms, toilets, bus-stands must be carried out & Anti-Ragging posters must be displayed at all prominent places like Admission Centre, Departments, Library, Canteen, Hostel, Common facilities etc. These posters are available on UGC website www.ugc.ac.in. The size of posters should be 8x6 feet. Any other measure which would augur well in preventing/quelling ragging and any uncalled for behaviour/incident must be undertaken.

Students in distress due to ragging related incidents can call the National Anti-Ragging Helpline 1800-180-5522 (24x7 Toll Free) or e-mail the Anti-Ragging Helpline at helpline@antiragging.in. For any other information regarding ragging you may please visit the UGC website i.e. www.ugc.ac.in & helpline@antiragging.in and contact UGC monitoring agency i.e. Centre for Youth (C4Y) on Mobile No.

UGC also drives an Anti-Ragging Media Campaign through different modes and has undertaken the following activities to promote the campaign which are available on UGC website i.e. www.ugc.ac.in

- a. UGC developed 05 TVCs of 30 seconds each with different perspective i.e. Parents, Victim and Offenders.
- b. UGC designed and distributed 04 types of posters amongst Universities / Regulatory Authorities / Councils / IITs / NITs / other educational institutions for their prominent display.
- c. UGC consecutively organized 02 Anti-Ragging Competitions for students/faculty/general public for the wider awareness of the menace of ragging.

In compliance of the 2^{nd} Amendment in UGC Regulations, you are requested to make it compulsory for each student and every parent to submit an online undertaking every academic year at www.antiragging.in

You are also requested to implement the revised procedure for students to file online Anti-Ragging affidavit. The student will receive an e-mail with his/her registration number. The student will forward that e-mail to the Nodal officer in his/her university/college e-mail. (Please note that the student will not receive pdf affidavits and he/she is not required to print & sign it as it used to be in the earlier case).

Universities/Colleges have to display the email address and contact number of the Nodal Officer of Anti-Ragging Committee of their university/college on their website and campus areas like Admission Centre, Departments, Library, Canteen, Hostel, and Common facilities, etc.

Vision:

Mission:

The proposal outlines the creation of an Anti Ragging Committee with the objective of efficiently preventing, prohibiting, and addressing occurrences of ragging.

Objectives:

The primary role of the Anti-Ragging Committee is to serve as a supervisory and advising body responsible for ensuring a college campus environment that is free from any occurrences of ragging. The key objectives of the committee are outlined as follows.

- In order to foster a climate of discipline, it is imperative to properly communicate a clear and unequivocal message that any form of ragging will be completely forbidden within the premises of the college campus.
- The objective is to effectively enforce strategies that prohibit, discourage, and eradicate instances of ragging, encompassing any manifestation of misconduct exhibited by students through verbal discourse, written means, or acts of provocation, mistreatment, or impoliteness. This involves both direct and indirect involvement in disruptive or disciplinary behaviours targeted against first-year students, second-year students, fourth-year students, and other peers.
- To ensure the efficient prevention and mitigation of incidents of ragging within the institution, it is crucial to build a comprehensive system that incorporates the monitoring directing, and oversight of the anti-ragging squads, hence assuring the effectiveness and other ency of their activities.

Roles and Responsibilities

- > It is imperative to adhere to and comply with the orders of the esteemed Supreme Court and exercise vigilance in identifying any incidents that may be classified as ragging.

- ➤ Enforcing the requisite protocols is of utmost importance in mitigating the occurrence of hazing within educational institutions and residential premises.

- The act of encouraging a student to engage in an activity that deviates from the usual routine, resulting in feelings of guilt, distress, or humiliation that negatively impact the student's physical and psychological well-being.
- > The word "senior student" pertains to those who have advanced further in their educational trajectory in comparison to their fellow students. When older students partake in actions that hinder, interrupt, or upset the normal educational pursuits of any other student, particularly those who are in their initial year of study, it can be deemed as an act of interference.
- > The utilization of the skills and abilities possessed by a novice or any other individual in a learning context to fulfill the academic responsibilities assigned to an individual or a collective of students.
- > The phenomenon of imposing financial extortion or coercive financial restraints upon freshman or other students by senior students or classmates.
- ➤ Instances of physical abuse encompass a variety of behaviours, such as sexual abuse, assaults based on sexual orientation, coerced removal of clothing, compelling individuals to engage in obscene and indecent acts, making offensive gestures, inflicting bodily harm, or posing any other type of threat to an individual's well-being or personal safety.
- ➤ Verbal abuse, internet communication, online posts, and public insults are many manifestations of mistreatment that involve purposely causing discomfort to a fresher or any other student, often accompanied by a sense of perverted pleasure, vicarious joy, or sadistic satisfaction.

The occurrence of any behaviour that impacts the mental well-being and self-assurance of a new student or any other student, regardless of whether it is motivated by sadistic pleasure or an exhibition of power, authority, or superiority by a fellow student.

Engaging in any of the aforementioned actions renders individuals susceptible to potential fines in accordance with the regulations outlined by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE).

Anti Ragging Committee Policy

Vision:

The main goal of this effort is to establish a ragging-free atmosphere within the campus of V. V. Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Gudlavalleru. The objective of this endeavor entails the execution of a diverse range of strategies aimed at prohibiting, deterring, and eliminating any form of misconduct demonstrated by students towards their fellow peers, with a specific emphasis on individuals in their initial and subsequent years of study. This involves the issue of ragging, along with various other forms of abuse or harassment.

Mission:

The proposal outlines the creation of an Anti Ragging Committee with the objective of efficiently preventing, prohibiting, and addressing occurrences of ragging.

Objectives:

The primary role of the Anti-Ragging Committee is to serve as a supervisory and advising body responsible for ensuring a college campus environment that is free from any occurrences of ragging. The key objectives of the committee are outlined as follows.

- ➤ In order to foster a climate of discipline, it is imperative to properly communicate a clear and unequivocal message that any form of ragging will be completely forbidden within the premises of the college campus.
- The objective is to effectively enforce strategies that prohibit, discourage, and eradicate instances of ragging, encompassing any manifestation of misconduct exhibited by students through verbal discourse, written means, or acts of provocation, mistreatment, or impoliteness. This involves both direct and indirect involvement in disruptive or disciplinary behaviours targeted against first-year students, second-year students, fourth-year students, and other peers.
- To ensure the efficient prevention and mitigation of incidents of ragging within the institution, it is crucial to build a comprehensive system that incorporates the monitoring, directing, and oversight of the anti-ragging squads, hence assuring the effectiveness and efficiency of their activities.

> The primary objective is to expeditiously and effectively address the reported incidents of ragging. Additionally, it is crucial to guarantee the appropriate acknowledgment and enforcement of relevant consequences for each instance of ragging.

Roles and Responsibilities

- > It is imperative to adhere to and comply with the orders of the esteemed Supreme Court and exercise vigilance in identifying any incidents that may be classified as ragging.

- > It is imperative to prioritize the prominent placement of Anti-ragging posters on department notice boards and specified areas throughout the institution.
- > The implementation of counseling programs aimed at improving students' comprehension of the occurrence of ragging, together with the associated consequences and legal actions enforced by law enforcement and judicial entities.
- > Enforcing the requisite protocols is of utmost importance in mitigating the occurrence of hazing within educational institutions and residential premises.

- > The act of encouraging a student to engage in an activity that deviates from the usual routine, resulting in feelings of guilt, distress, or humiliation that negatively impact the student's physical and psychological well-being.
- > The word "senior student" pertains to those who have advanced further in their educational trajectory in comparison to their fellow students. When older students partake in actions that hinder, interrupt, or upset the normal educational pursuits of any other student, particularly those who are in their initial year of study, it can be deemed as an act of interference.
- > The utilization of the skills and abilities possessed by a novice or any other individual in a learning context to fulfill the academic responsibilities assigned to an individual or a collective of students.
- > The phenomenon of imposing financial extortion or coercive financial restraints upon freshman or other students by senior students or classmates.
- ➤ Instances of physical abuse encompass a variety of behaviours, such as sexual abuse, assaults based on sexual orientation, coerced removal of clothing, compelling individuals to engage in obscene and indecent acts, making offensive gestures, inflicting bodily harm, or posing any other type of threat to an individual's well-being or personal safety.
- ➤ Verbal abuse, internet communication, online posts, and public insults are many manifestations of mistreatment that involve purposely causing discomfort to a fresher or any other student, often accompanied by a sense of perverted pleasure, vicarious joy, or sadistic satisfaction.

The occurrence of any behaviour that impacts the mental well-being and self-assurance of a new student or any other student, regardless of whether it is motivated by sadistic pleasure or an exhibition of power, authority, or superiority by a fellow student.

Engaging in any of the aforementioned actions renders individuals susceptible to potential fines in accordance with the regulations outlined by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE).

You are requested to conduct meetings with the senior students and people from the Academic Institutions, Judiciary, Police Department etc., on the Act provisions and guidelines of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the UGC on the issue of ragging.

Mission:

The proposal entails the establishment of an Anti Ragging Committee, which aims to effectively prevent, prohibit, and address instances of ragging.

Objectives:

The Anti-Ragging Committee will function as the supervisory and advisory entity tasked with maintaining a college campus atmosphere that is devoid of any instances of ragging. The committee's principal objectives are as follows.

- > To cultivate an environment of discipline, it is crucial to effectively convey a prominent message that any manifestation of ragging would be strictly prohibited within the confines of the college campus.
- The aim is to implement measures that efficiently ban, deter, and eliminate occurrences of ragging, embracing any form of misbehavior displayed by pupils through verbal communication, writing methods, or actions of taunting, abuse, or rudeness. This encompasses both direct and indirect participation in disruptive or disciplinary actions directed towards first-year students, second-year students, fourth-year students, and other peers.
- > To ensure the successful prevention and mitigation of ragging within the institution, it is crucial to build a comprehensive system that monitors, directs, and oversees the activities and effectiveness of the anti-ragging squads.

> To promptly and efficiently tackle the reported cases of ragging.

> To ensure proper recognition and imposition of suitable penalties for every occurrence of ragging.

Roles and Responsibilities

- > It is of utmost importance to comply with and adhere to the instructions of the renowned Supreme Court and maintain vigilance in recognizing any occurrences that may be categorized as ragging.
- ➤ It is imperative to keep a perpetual level of attentiveness throughout both daytime and nighttime within the college premises and other vulnerable regions, particularly those prone to instances of ragging. It is imperative to grant individuals the authority to carry out inspections in said sites.
- > The utilization of unanticipated raids on residential halls and other vulnerable locations possesses the potential to effectively reduce occurrences of hazing.
- ➤ It is strongly advised by the faculty, student body, parents, and guardians that any reported incident of ragging be promptly subjected to an urgent investigation. The results of the inquiry, along with suggested courses of action, will be expeditiously transmitted to the institution's leader for suitable measures to be taken.
- > Ensuring the conspicuous display of Anti-ragging posters on department notice boards and designated spots inside the university is of utmost importance.
- The introduction of counseling initiatives designed to enhance students' understanding of the phenomenon of ragging, together with the corresponding repercussions and legal measures imposed by law enforcement and judicial authorities.
- > It is crucial to enforce the necessary protocols in order to prevent the incidence of hazing within the campus and residential facilities.

- ➤ Instances of physical abuse encompass a range of behaviors, including but not limited to sexual abuse, assaults motivated by sexual orientation, coerced removal of clothing, forcing individuals to engage in obscene and indecent acts, making offensive gestures, causing bodily harm, or posing any other form of threat to an individual's well-being or personal safety.
- ➤ Verbal abuse, internet correspondence, online posts, or public insults are forms of mistreatment that can be characterized by deriving perverse pleasure, vicarious joy, or sadistic delight from intentionally causing discomfort to a fresher or any other student.

The presence of any conduct that affects the psychological welfare and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student, irrespective of whether it is driven by sadistic gratification or a demonstration of power, authority, or superiority by a peer.

Participating in any of the aforementioned activities makes individuals liable to face fines as per the laws stipulated by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) statutes.

Vision

The vision of this initiative is to establish a "Ragging-Free" atmosphere inside the premises of V. V. Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Gudlavalleru, by implementing measures aimed at prohibiting, preventing, and eliminating any form of misconduct shown by students towards their fellow students, particularly freshers and sophomores. This includes addressing the issue of ragging, as well as other forms of mistreatment or harassment.

Mission:

Establish an Anti Ragging Committee with the purpose of preventing, prohibiting, and addressing incidents of ragging.

Objectives:

The Anti-Ragging Committee shall serve as the overseeing and consultative body responsible for upholding a culture of a campus environment free from ragging inside the college. The primary aims of this committee are as follows.

- > In order to establish a climate of discipline, it is imperative to communicate a preeminent message that any form of ragging will not be permitted within the college premises.
- The objective is to establish measures that effectively prohibit, prevent, and eradicate instances of ragging, encompassing any form of misconduct exhibited by students through verbal communication, written means, or acts of teasing, mistreatment, or rudeness. This includes both direct and indirect engagement in rowdy or disciplinary activities targeting freshers, sophomores, seniors, and fellow students.
- > In order to ensure effective prevention and mitigation of ragging within the institution, it is imperative to establish a system for monitoring, directing, and overseeing the operations and efficacy of the anti-ragging squads.

> In order to address swiftly and effectively the instances of ragging that are reported.

> In order to ensure that each instance of ragging is duly acknowledged and subject to appropriate consequences.

Roles and Responsibilities

- It is imperative to adhere to and abide by the directives of the esteemed Supreme Court and remain alert in identifying any instances that may be classified as ragging.
- ❖ It is necessary to maintain a constant state of vigilance throughout the day and night within the campus and other areas that are susceptible to incidents, particularly those with the potential for ragging. Individuals should be authorized to conduct inspections in such locations.
- The implementation of surprise raids on dormitories and other susceptible areas has the ability to mitigate incidences of ragging.
- An immediate investigation shall be conducted into any reported instance of ragging, as recommended by the staff, student, parent, or guardian. The findings of the investigation, along with recommendations, shall be promptly forwarded to the head of the institution for appropriate action.
- ❖ It is imperative to ensure the prominent placement of Anti-ragging posters on department notice boards and other specified areas inside the institution.
- The implementation of counseling programs aimed at raising awareness among students regarding the issue of ragging, as well as the associated consequences and punishments administered by the police and justice departments.
- ❖ It is imperative to implement all requisite procedures to avoid the occurrence of ragging within the campus and hostel premises.

Notification

Sub: Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in V. V. Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences

As per UGC and AICTE norms, all students to know the following details with regarding to ragging.

Misconduct perpetrated by students, whether by verbal or written communication, or through actions that result in the taunting, mistreatment, or rudeness towards a freshers or any other student.

1. Engaging in boisterous or undisciplined behaviors by individual students or a group of students that result in, or have the potential to result in, aggravation, adversity, physical or psychological harm, instilling fear, or any negative impact on new students or any other student.

- 2. Requesting any student to engage in an activity that deviates from the usual routine and results in feelings of shame, misery, or embarrassment that negatively impact the physical or psychological well-being of any student.
- 3. Any action undertaken by senior students that hinders, interrupts, or upsets the normal educational pursuits of any other student, particularly a first-year student.
- 4. The utilization of the skills and abilities of a novice or any other student to fulfill the academic responsibilities given to an individual or a collective of students.
- 5. The act of imposing financial extortion or coercive financial burdens on a freshman or any other student by senior students or other peers.
- 6. Any instance of physical abuse, encompassing all forms of sexual abuse, assaults based on sexual orientation, coerced removal of clothing, compelling individuals to engage in obscene and indecent behaviors, making offensive gestures, inflicting bodily harm, or posing any other threat to one's well-being or personal safety.
- 7. Any instance of verbal abuse, electronic communication, online posts, or public insults, which may involve obtaining perverse pleasure, vicarious satisfaction, or sadistic gratification from actively or passively engaging in the discomfort of a new student or any other student.
- 8. The occurrence of any behavior that impacts the mental well-being and self-assurance of a first-year student or any other student, regardless of whether it is motivated by sadistic pleasure or a display of power, authority, or superiority by a fellow student.

Engaging in any of the aforementioned actions renders individuals subject to penalties in accordance with the regulations outlined by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) acts.
