WOMEN GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL POLICY

Vision:


To cultivate a workplace or community where every woman feels respected, valued, and safe from all forms of harassment and discrimination, fostering an environment of equality, empowerment and dignity.

Mission:

To Prevent, prohibit and redressal of sexual harassment of women employee and students of the institution.

- 1. Establish a culture that prioritizes the safety and well-being of women. Provide a secure and confidential platform for women to report grievances without fear of retaliation.
- 2. Ensure swift and impartial investigation and resolution of grievances.
- 3. Uphold principles of natural justice, transparency, and fairness throughout the grievance redressal process.
- 4. Conduct regular awareness programs and training to educate employees or community members on acceptable behaviour, gender sensitivity, and the consequences of harassment.
- 5. Foster a culture of mutual respect, understanding, and collaboration.
- 6. Regularly review and update policies to align with evolving best practices and legal requirements.
- 7. Collect feedback from stakeholders to identify areas for improvement and enhance the effectiveness of the grievance redressal mechanism.
- 8. We are providing a safe and secured environment to the women employees and female students of our institution. This Policy aims to provide detailed procedures for redressal of grievances and to prevent any incident of sexual harassment.
- 9. The policy also aims to the provisions of Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 & Rules made there under and provide protection against sexual harassment of women and students at the workplace and to prevent any type of harassment and make the campus environment safe and secure to women.





10. V. V. Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences always aims to provide safe and secured atmosphere in the campus for the woman. This redressal grievance has come to force on date of establishment.

Objective:

The objective of the policy shall be as under:

The women's grievance committee will address cases and complaints of sexual harassment and other forms of harassment against female students, teaching staff, and non-teaching women personnel at the institution. Its purpose is to promote the well-being of women.

• Cultivate a favorable workplace environment that upholds principles of fairness, dignity, and professionalism.

• The grievance procedure will address all individual complaints and promptly implement appropriate measures.

• To offer support to the Faculty in implementing proactive measures to address issues related to gender discrimination and sexual harassment.

• To establish suitable working circumstances that prioritize work, leisure, health, and hygiene, with the aim of preventing any unfriendly environment for women in the workplace.

• The purpose is to establish a systematic process for addressing complaints regarding sexual harassment of female students, as well as female teaching and non-teaching staff on campus.

• Continuously evaluate the effectiveness of the policy, make necessary improvements, and stay abreast of evolving best practices and legal requirements.

Sexual Harassment Defined:

Sexual Harassment shall include any one or more of the following acts (whether directly or by implication) namely:

- 1. Unwanted Sexual Advances
- 2. Requests for Sexual Favors
- 3. Sexual Comments or Jokes.
- 4. Display of Sexually Explicit Material
- 5. Sexual Intimidation
- 6. Inappropriate Touching or Physical Contact
- 7. Sexual Discrimination
- 8. Online Sexual Harassment

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9. Any other physical, verbal or non-verbal conduct of sexual nature in any way.

Formation of the Internal Complaints Committee:

An Internal Complaints Committee will be established to address the complaints of female students and staff, whether they are teaching or non-teaching personnel. The ICC will consist of members who will be appointed by the employer. The user did not provide any text.

1. A female employee at a senior level inside the organization will also serve as a coordinator.

3. The Committee shall consist of at least three Members who are dedicated to promoting women's rights, have experience in social work, or possess legal expertise. The Member who is a woman and has legal knowledge will serve as the Secretary and Convener of the Committee.

4. The committee must consist of at least half of the total members, and these proposed members must be women.

Committee Meeting:

1. The committee is required to convene a minimum of two times during each academic year.

2. The chairperson of the committee has the authority to convene a special meeting upon receiving a written request from at least one-third of the committee members. The meeting must be scheduled within 5 days of the chairperson receiving the request.

Complaint of sexual harassment:

The subsequent protocol must be adhered to when addressing a complaint regarding Sexual Harassment:

• The complaint box will be opened on a weekly basis to gather and categorize the concerns. If the complainant wishes, it will be promptly opened.

• Allegations of harassment will be expeditiously and meticulously examined. The investigation will encompass conducting interviews with all pertinent individuals, including the complainant and other prospective witnesses, in relation to the sexual harassment matter. The determination of grievances will be made by a suitably high-ranking authority. Upon receiving complaints, the committee will make a suitable decision based on the service rules that apply to the Respondent. If there are no specific service rules, the decision will be made according to the rules established under the Act. The committee will then inform the





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complainant of the decision within fifteen days, as a general practice. If the complaint is of a complex nature, the decision-making process may be prolonged.

• In cases where both parties are employees at the same workplace, they will have the chance to present their arguments during the investigation. Additionally, both parties will receive a copy of the investigation's findings, allowing them to provide their own responses to the findings before the Committee.

• If the individual filing the complaint is dissatisfied with the decision made, she has the option to escalate the matter to either the Local Complaints Committee or the National Commission for Women.

• The Complaints Committee is required to keep a record of all complaints in a Complaint Register. The document ought to be classified as confidential.

Procedure for conducting an inquiry:

1. The ICC shall adhere to the subsequent protocol for investigating or examining the complaints it receives.

2. Any female employee or student of the University Departments, Schools, Administration, or Authority has the privilege to file a complaint with any member of the Cell. Complaints can be expressed either verbally or in written form.

3. A written complaint must be signed by the complainant. If the complaint is made verbally, it must be thoroughly documented in writing by the Cell member who receives the complaint. The complaint will not be addressed until it is signed by the person making the complaint.

4. A register for complaints shall be maintained by the Complaints Committee. This material should be classified as confidential. The person making the complaint will be given complete secrecy at this time.

5. If a complaint is made to any member of the Cell, that member must promptly notify the Chairperson of the Cell within a maximum of ten working days. Nevertheless, if the person making the complaint wishes, her identity will be treated as confidential and will only be disclosed to the designated Cell.

6. Within a span of three weeks following the communication the hairperson will arrange a meeting.





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7. The initial meeting, scheduled to take place within three weeks of receiving the complaint, will provide an opportunity for the complainant, or her representative if requested, to explain their case.

8. If a female complainant explicitly requests to give her deposition in the presence of only female members of the Cell, the Cell will proceed with the hearing after the male members have left.

9. The complaint will not be conclusively resolved until the male members of the Cell are present and actively involved in the decision-making process. The Cell will then determine if the complaint warrants further action. If the complainant fails to provide sufficient evidence of sexual harassment, as determined by the Cell, the case will be dismissed.

10. If the Cell decides to proceed with the complaint, the complainant's preferences will be determined. If the complainant believes that a warning is sufficient, the alleged offender will be summoned to a meeting with the Cell. They will be given an opportunity to present their side, and if the Cell is convinced that a warning is appropriate, it will recommend to the Vice Chancellor that the offender be cautioned about their behavior.

11. The issue will be considered resolved if a record is filed in the Complaint Register to indicate this. Upon the Vice Chancellor's endorsement of the recommendation, the individual was cautioned regarding their conduct, and it was deemed imperative to include this in the employee's Service Book or the student's Record, which includes the Migration Certificate. The Cell should ensure that the activity conducted is in conformity.

12. Prior to conducting the investigation, the Cell will determine if the wrongdoer should be suspended or barred from entering the premises during the investigation, taking into consideration the seriousness and nature of the alleged offense. If the Cell determines that such action is required, it will recommend it to the Vice Chancellor.

13. The Cell will provide the criminal with a fair and reasonable chance to defend themselves and will ensure that the standards of natural justice are followed.

14. If the person making the complaint wants to take further action beyond just giving a warning to the person who has done wrong, the Cell will provide a written notice to the person, giving them a chance to explain themselves within two weeks. They must provide valid reasons why they should not be considered guilty of their behavior and not be recommended for punishment for the reported action.





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15. If the written explanation provided by the delinquent is deemed unsatisfactory or if no written explanation is provided at all, the cell will promptly determine whether the offense warrants a minor or a significant penalty. If the Cell determines that the delinquent should receive a minor punishment, the Cell will suggest a specific minor penalty to the Vice Chancellor, who will promptly take action based on this advice.

Penalties and Punishment for Sexual Harassment: The International Criminal Court (ICC) has the authority to propose the following sanctions for individuals who are convicted of sexual harassment.

Sanctions for Staff: An employee who is found guilty of sexual harassment must be subject to the following penalties.

Minor Penalties:

- 1. Warning, reprimand, or censure.
- 2. Fined
- 3. Apology in written form.
- 4. Agreement to adhere to acceptable conduct.
- 5. Prohibiting access to a hostel, campus, or off-campus area.
- 6. Imposition of a predetermined duration of suspension.
- 7. Suppressing or concealing outcomes.
- 8. Non-disbursement of salary increases or advancement in job position.
- 9. Demotion to a lower pay grade or a lower step in the pay scale.

Primary consequences:

- 1. Mandatory retirement.
- 2. Service termination.
- 3. Termination of employment.
- 4. Imposing a temporary ban on taking examinations.
- 5. Institute expulsion.

a) The Institute will determine whether the individual accused of sexual harassment should be suspended. An employee who is suspended will receive a subsistence payment at the rates specified in the disciplinary rules.

b) Student sanctions: A student who is determined to subject to the following sanctions.

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Penalties for false or malicious complaints and fabricated evidence: If the International Criminal Court (ICC) determines that the accusation against the accused is intentionally false or that the complainant, whether it be the aggrieved woman or any other individual, knowingly made a false complaint or presented counterfeit or deceptive documents, the ICC may advise the employer or District Officer to initiate disciplinary measures against them.
